- Ensure 100% of students improve their A-E writing results through explicit teaching embedded in the whole school writing approach, and the development of personalised writing plans based on the Literacy Continuum facilitated through an inquiry cycle for each student.
- Embed the *Australian Curriculum: Technologies*.

Continue building capacity of teachers in the teaching of writing across learning areas and phonemic awareness through access to professional development and implementing collaborative processes between teacher, teacher aides and principal.

Use the inquiry cycle model to develop personalised teaching and learning plans for every student.

Collaborate to identify the targeted teaching and learning strategies for each student.

Purchase additional STLaN time to support students' learning in literacy and numeracy with a focus on the Early Years.

Continue to support STEM Education by partnering with the IMPACT centre.
